- By car: Drive along the road A9 towards Nürnberg. Exit at Allershausen and continue 5 km to west.

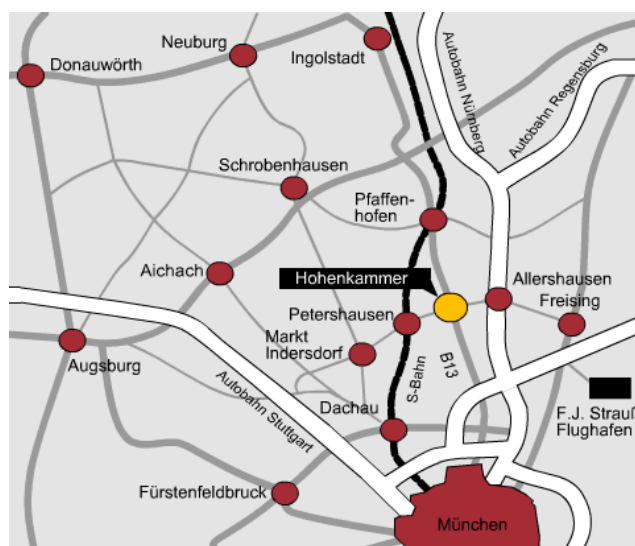
